Exploring the changing Art and Design curriculum

A two day FREE CPD event for Teachers

in Lambeth, Southwark and Tower Hamlets at Tate Modern

With the input of specialist speakers these events set out to open up discussion, ask questions and explore the changing art and design curriculum. In these two 3-hour sessions the intention is to use Tate Modern as a site of enquiry, where both visual and written prompts will be used to encourage investigation.

The first session will provide the opportunity to hear our four speakers present their views on what art education will look like in schools in the coming decade and will offer a platform for dialogue about changes to the art and design curriculum. The second session will be an opportunity to take on board the outcomes of week one and develop some practical solutions to take back to the classroom.
