These features form the values or ingredients that support their delivery of joint work of value, in the case of cultural and creative learning: activity which has a significant impact on cultural learning and engagement, which can only be achieved by organisations working powerfully together.

Sharing expertise and assets.

Making the collective extraordinary.

Partnership stages



We have found that partnerships typically go through the following 5 stages of development. For each stage we have highlighted a few Powerful Partnerships ingredients that might be particularly important...

<u>Discover and build</u> – The early stages of a partnership

- Building a relevant and diverse membership
- Beginning to consider local and user need
- Beginning to identify a clear set of purposes

<u>Define</u> – Forming a vision and a strategy

- Enable all partners to contribute
- Attend to individual partners' priorities
- Address local and user need

<u>Develop</u> – Building the future programme

- Undertake collaborative action
- Create a clear shared identity
- Provide clear and mutual benefit
- Secure and share resources and opportunities

<u>Deliver</u>— Effective governance during the production of the work

- Deliver shared impact
- Create opportunities for shared learning
- Grow trusting relationships

<u>Do more</u> – Keeping up momentum

- Secure and share resources and opportunities
- Create a clear shared identity
- Address local and user need
