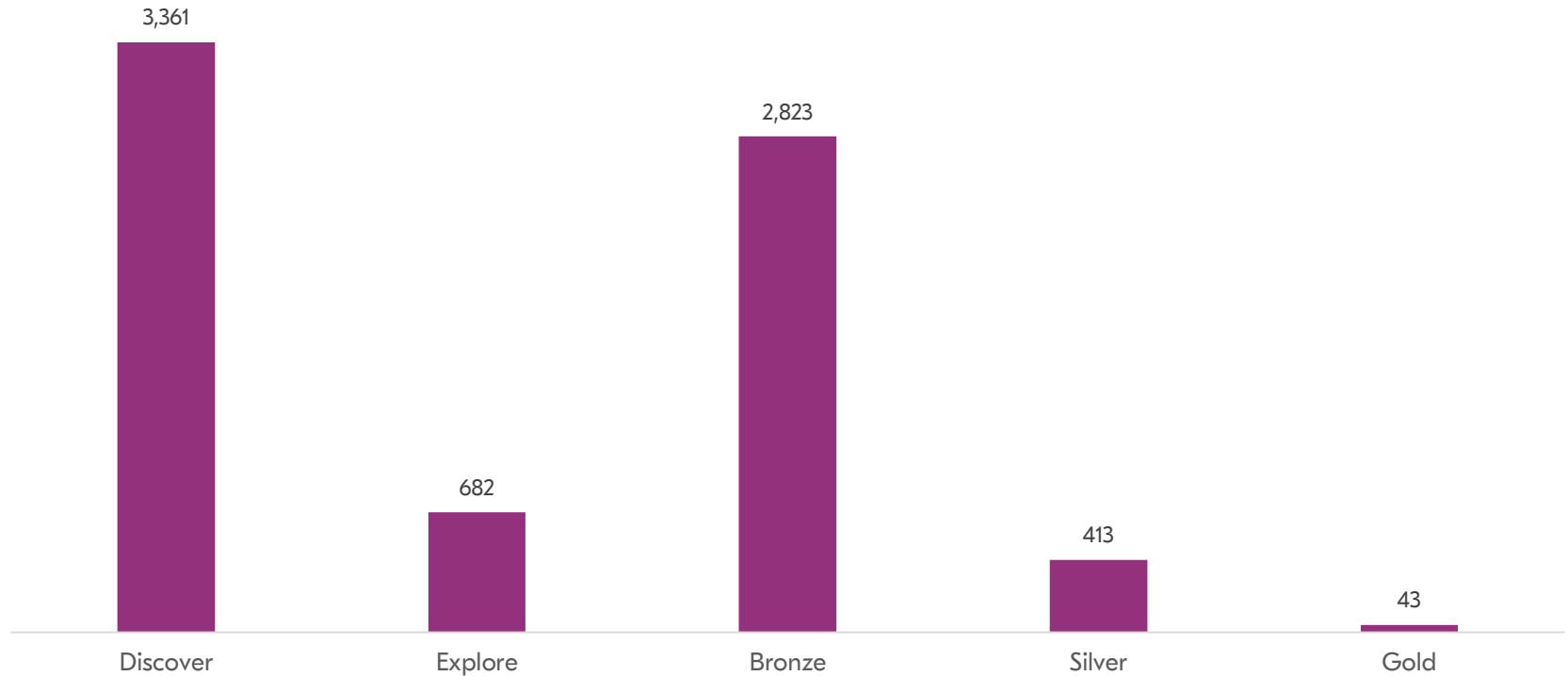

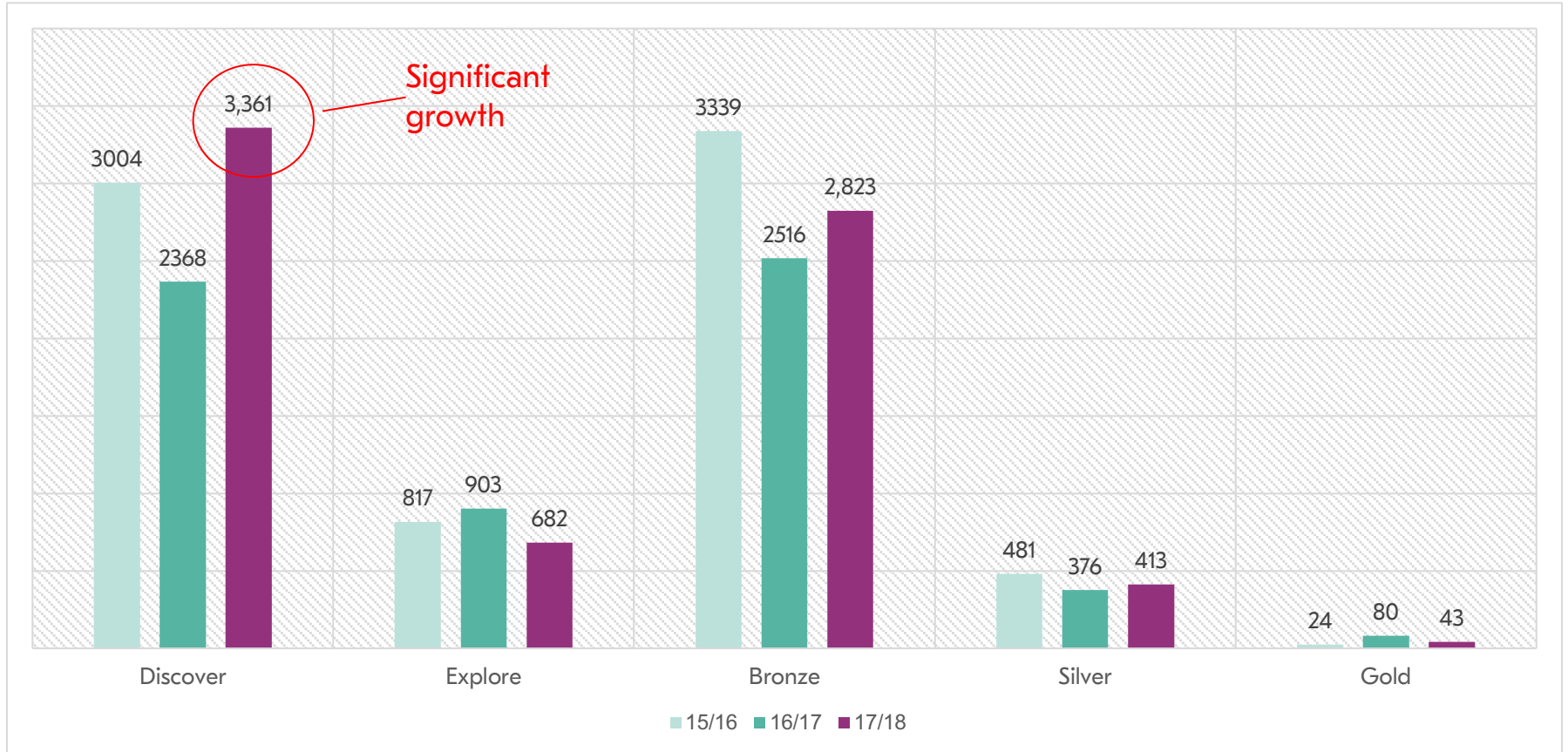

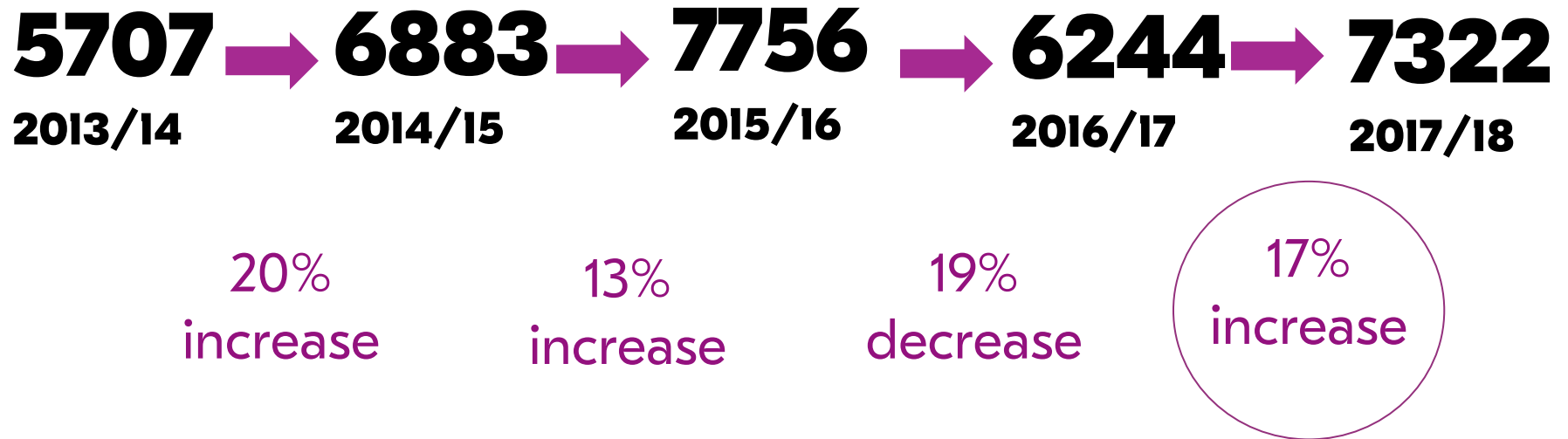

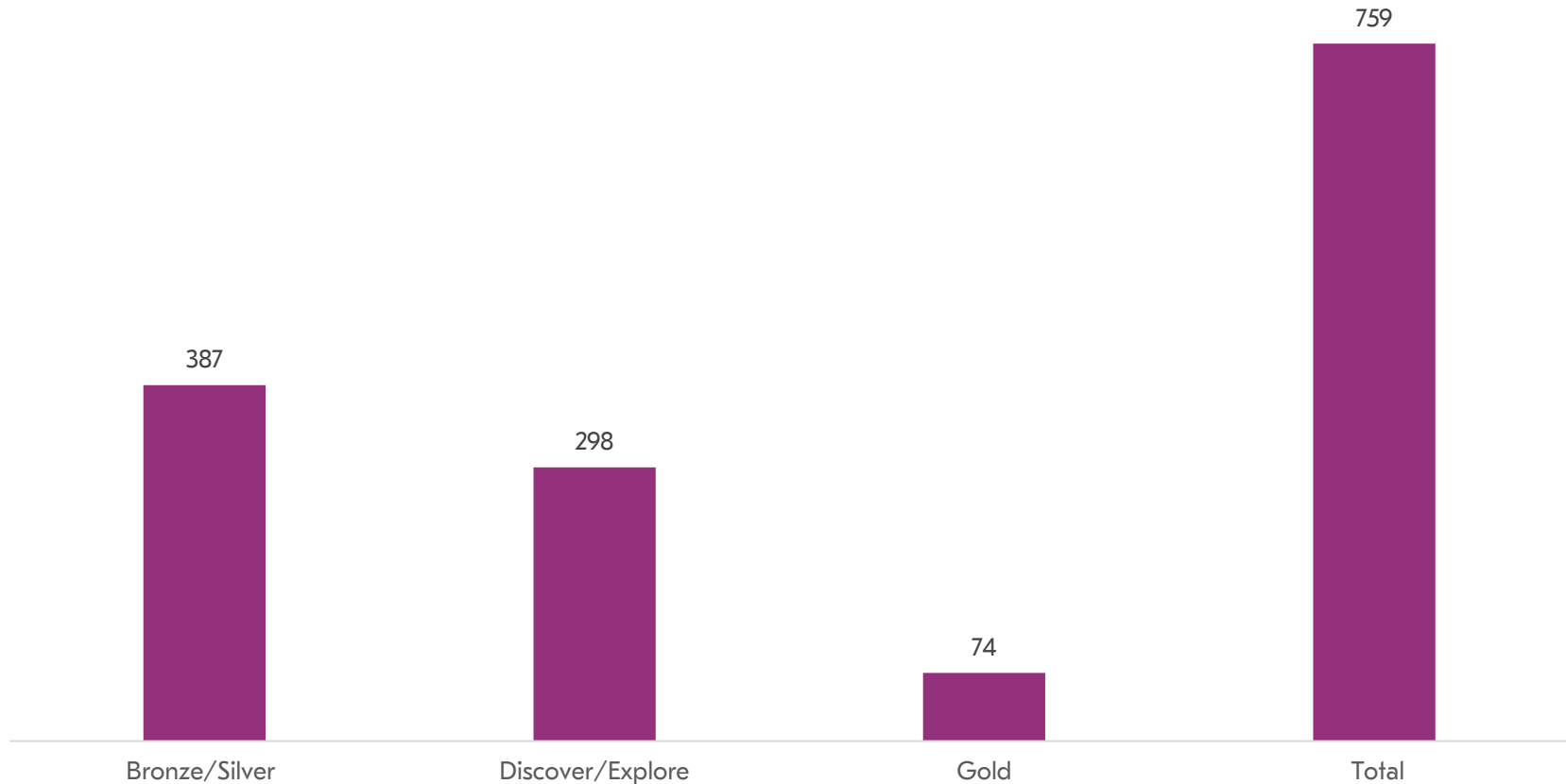

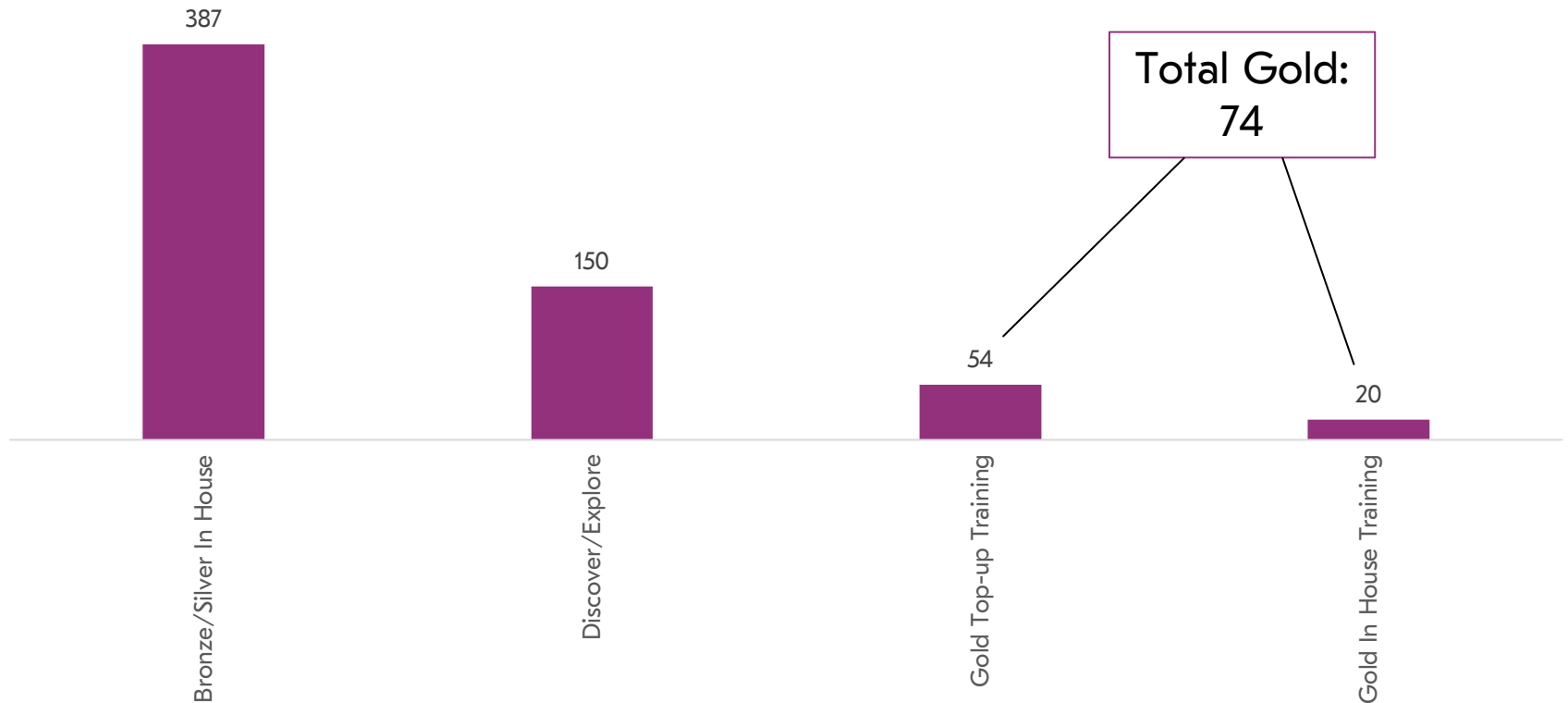
Total advisers trained in London

Total advisers trained in London: Gold



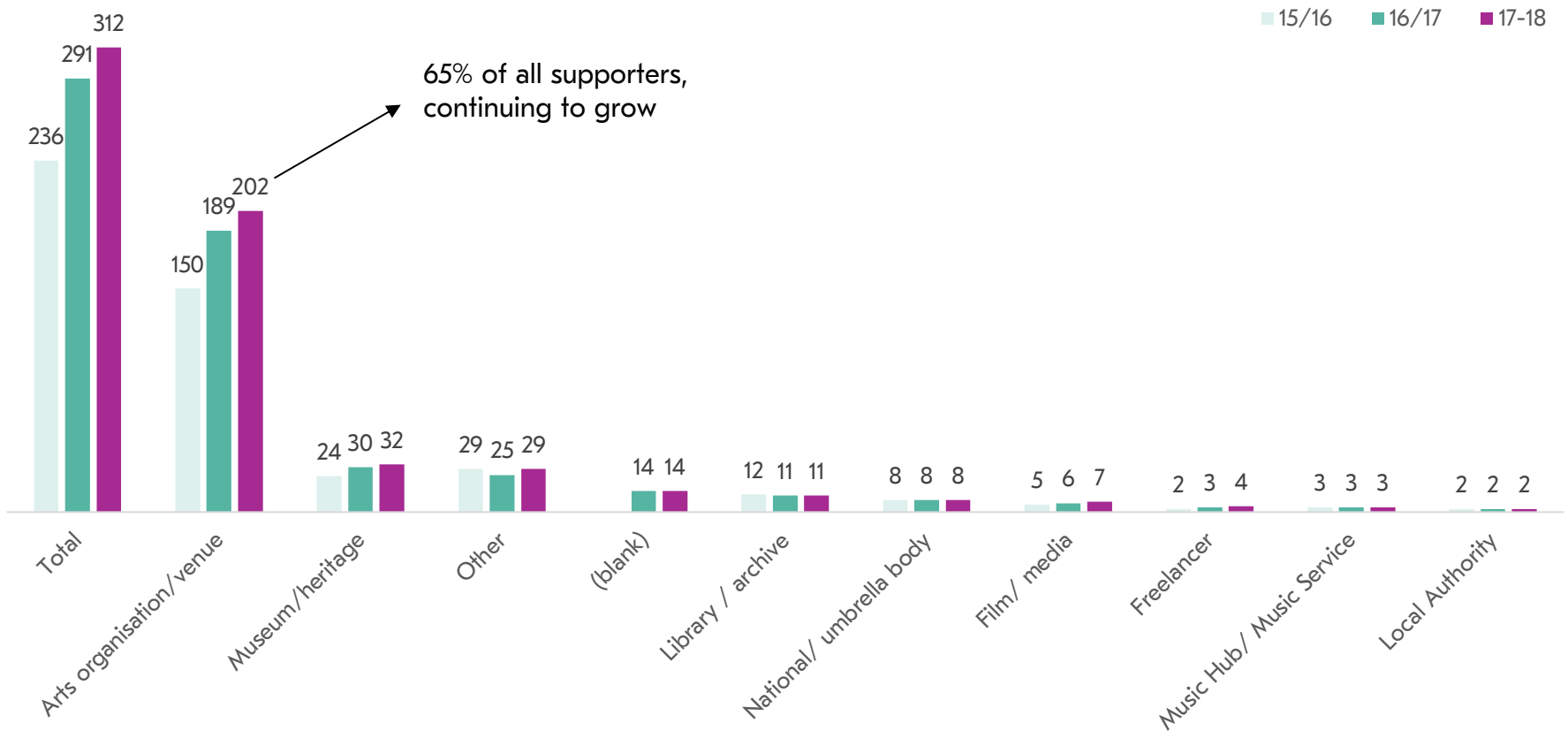

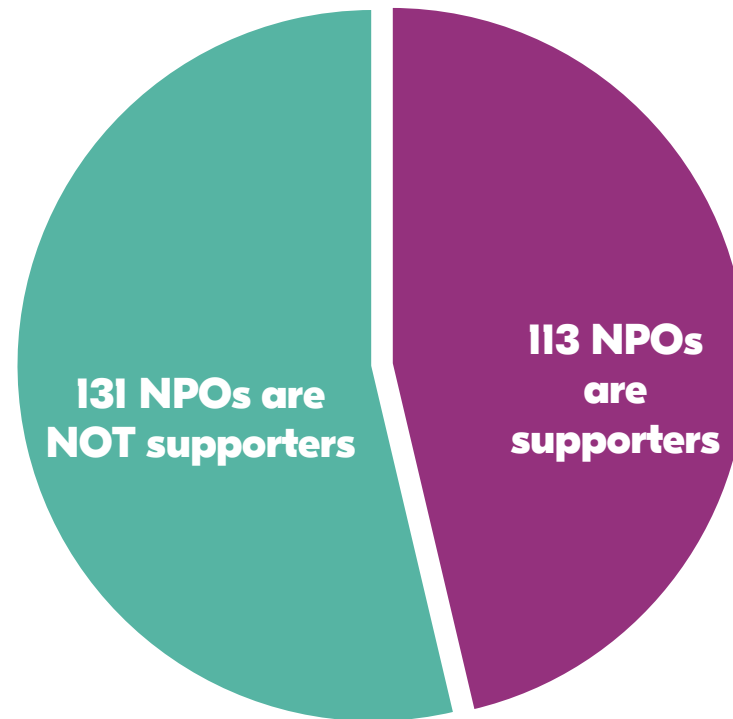

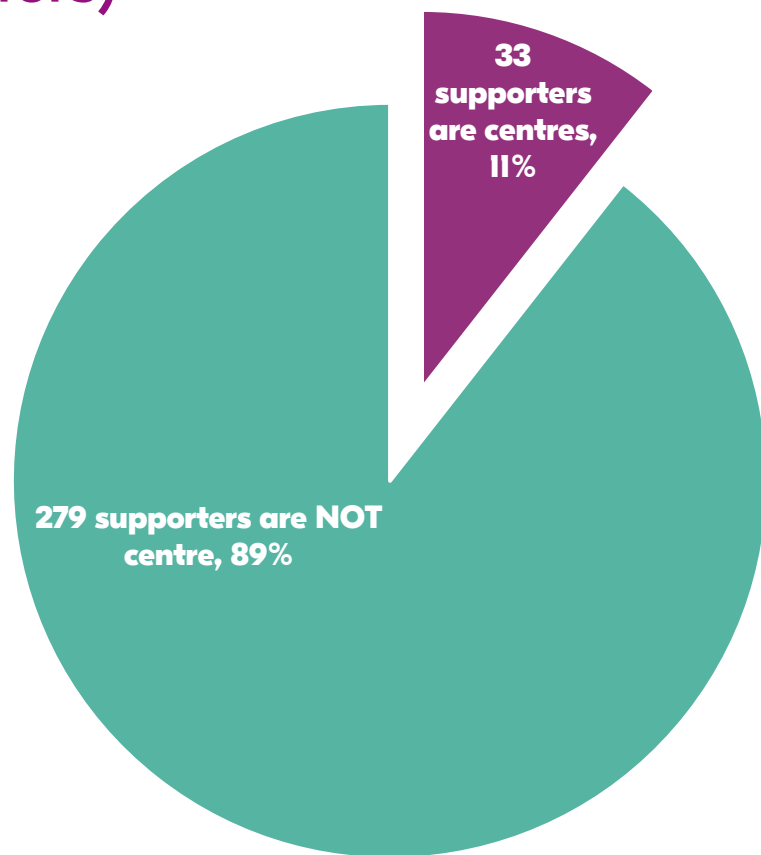
NPOs that are Arts Award supporters

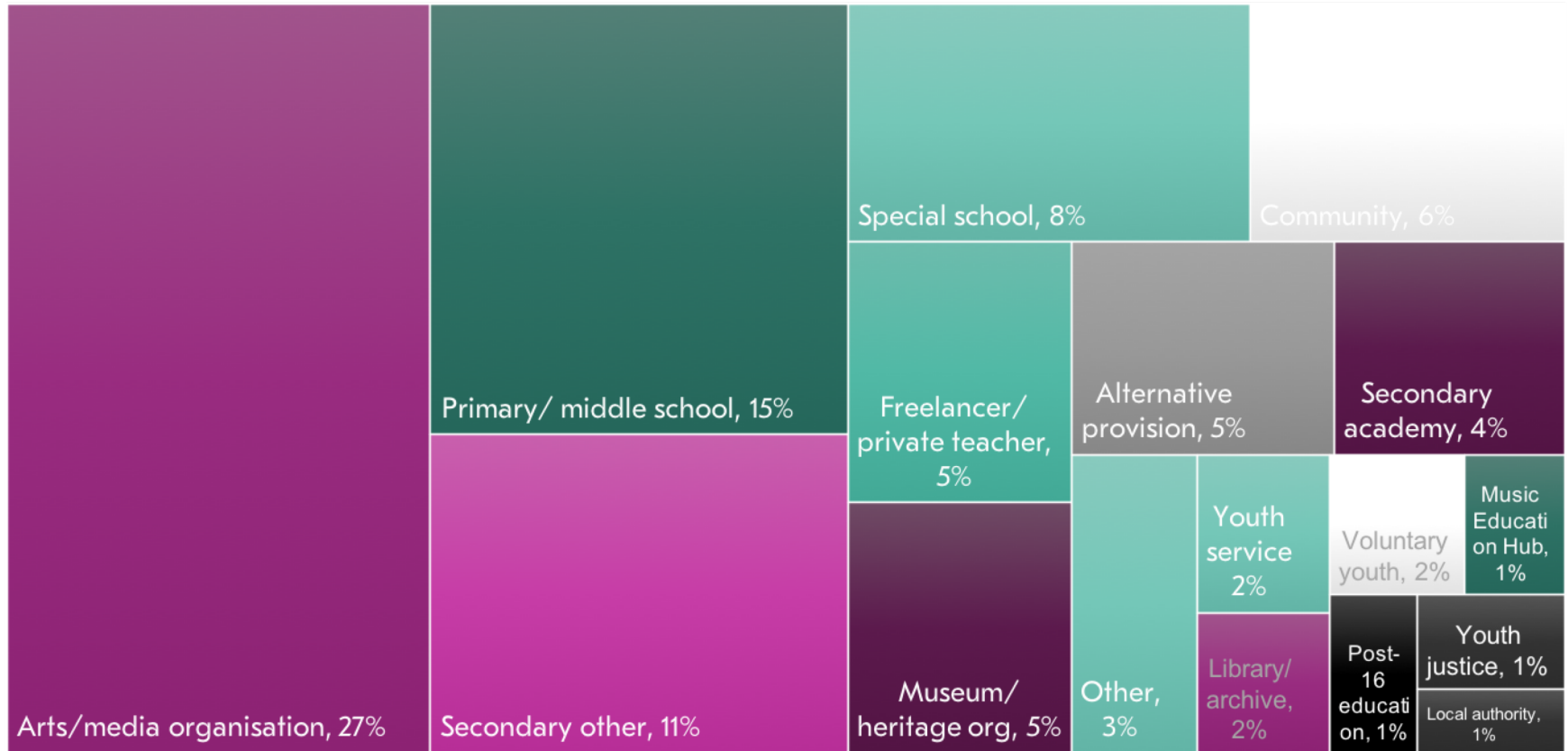

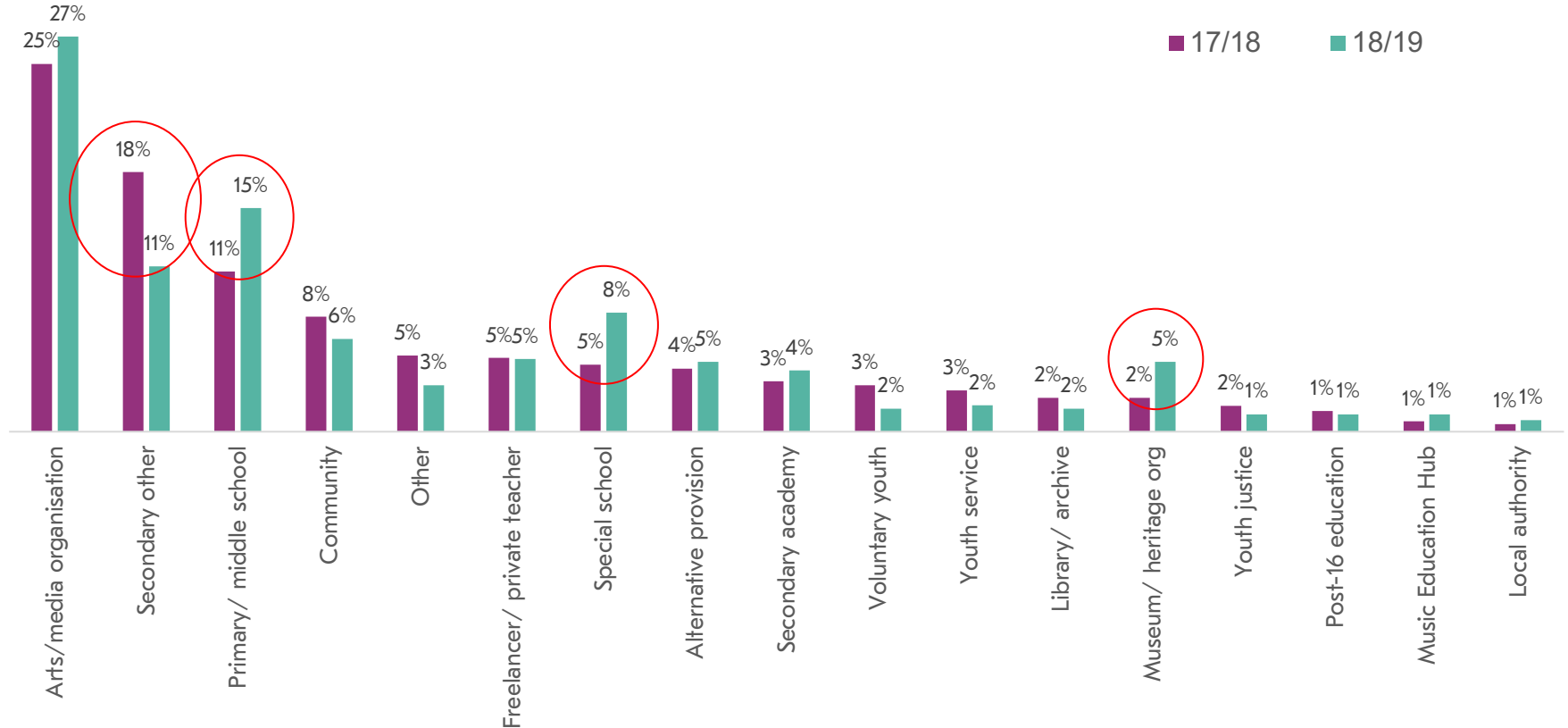
By sub-sector (%)

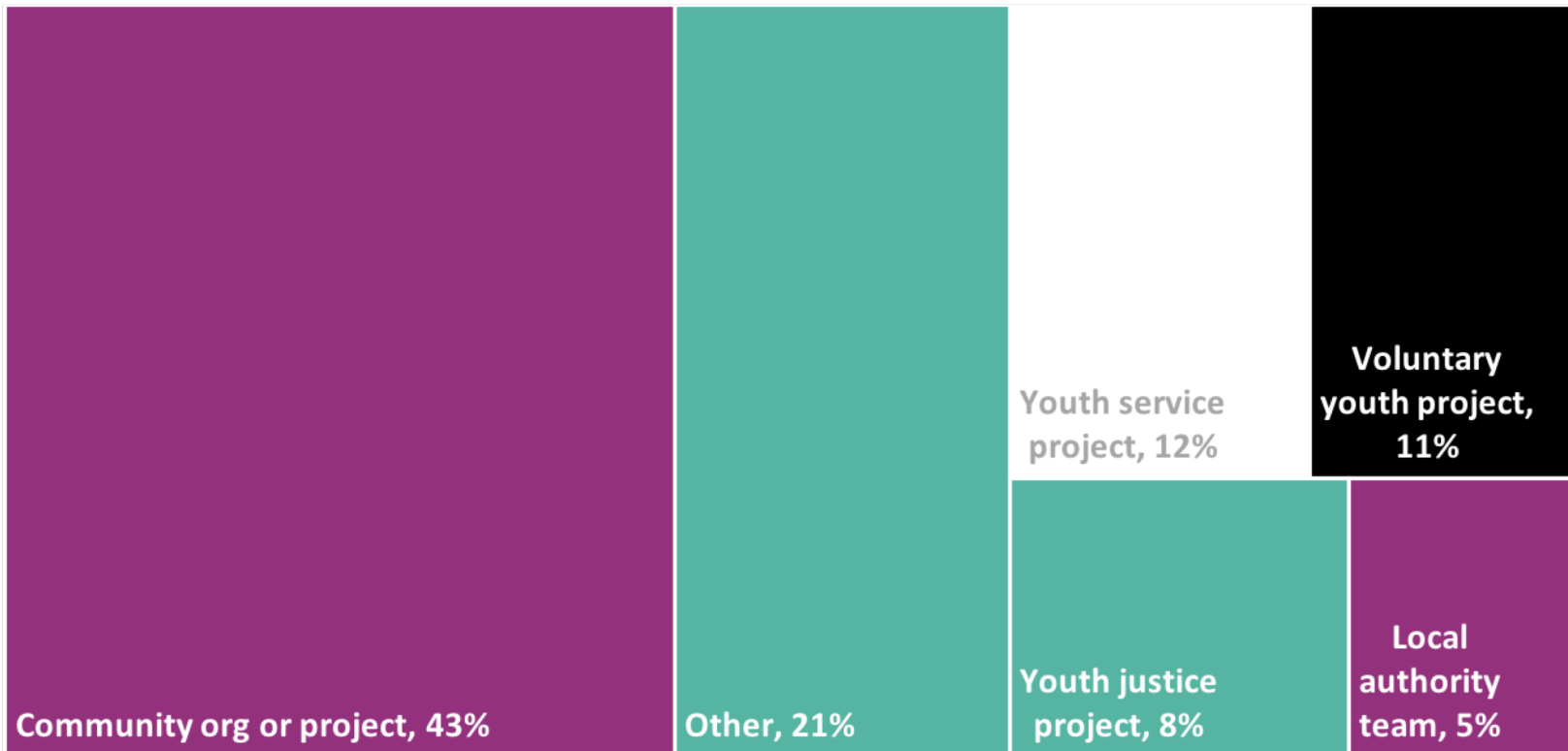

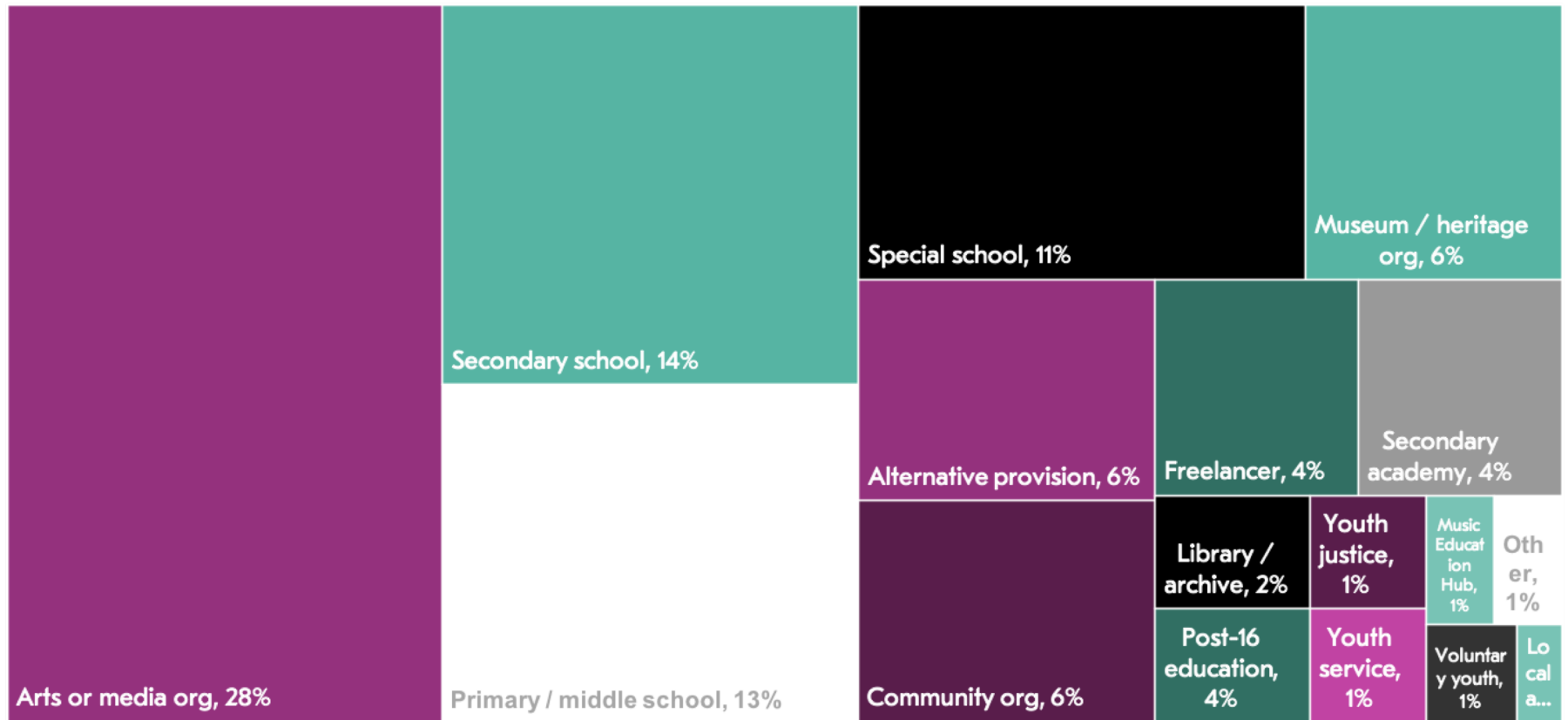

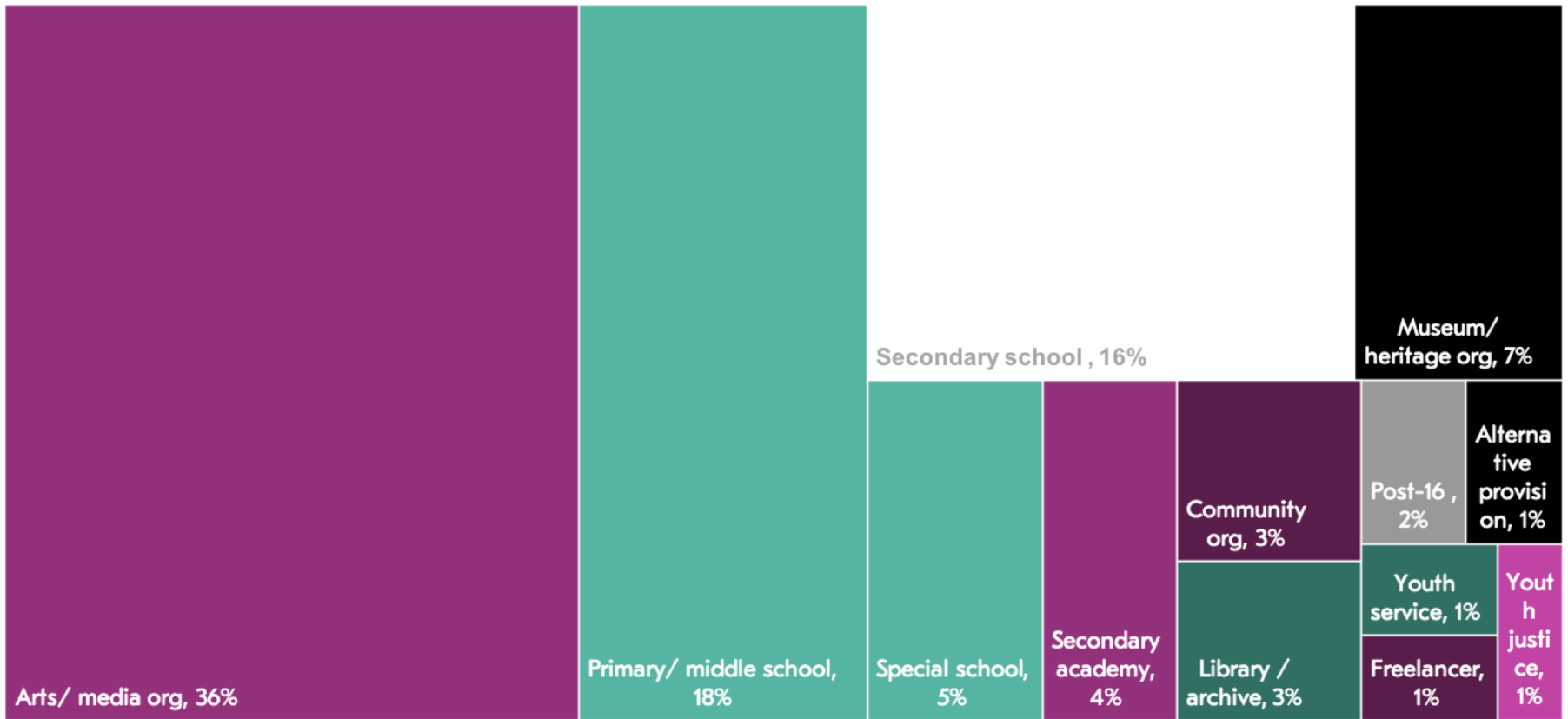
By sub-sector (%)

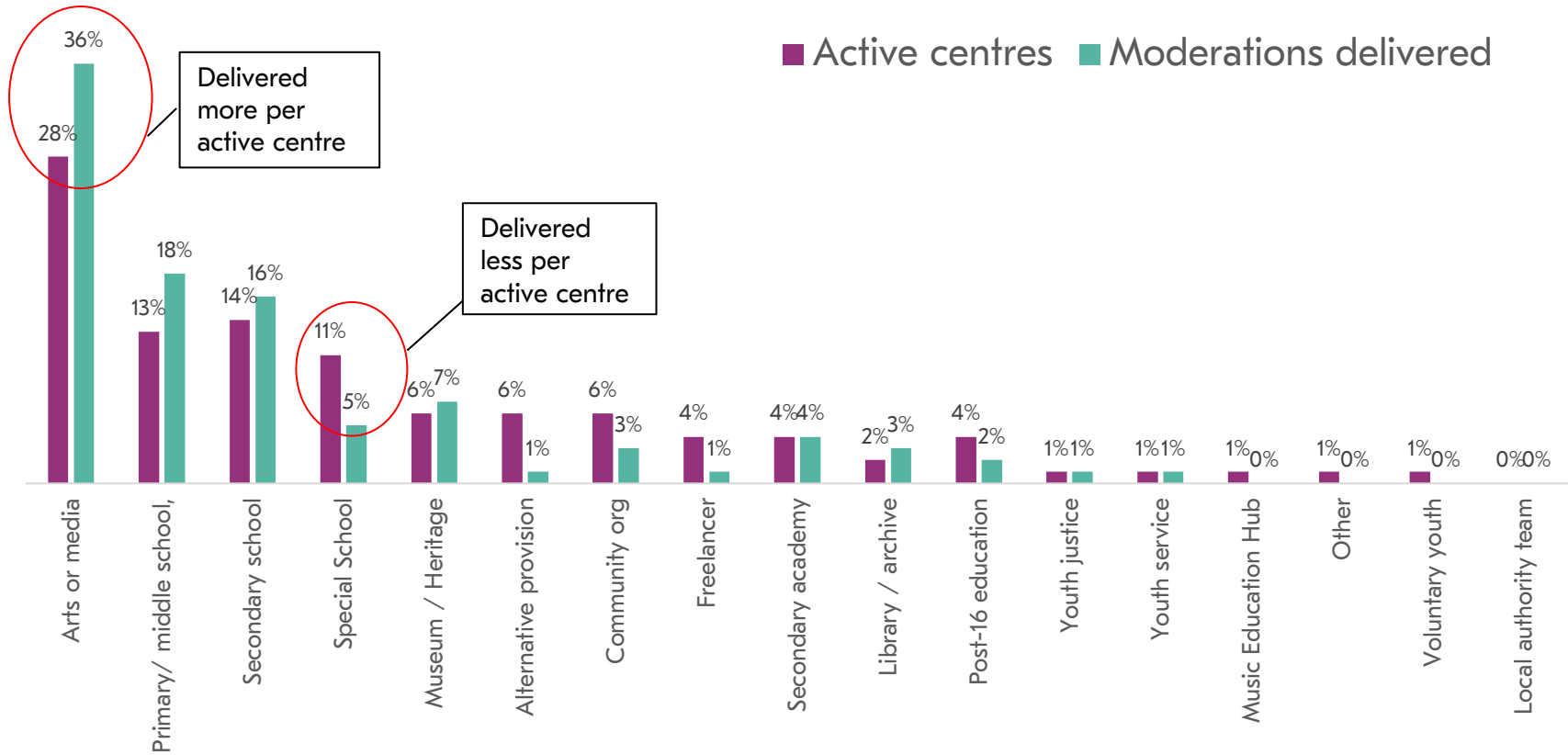

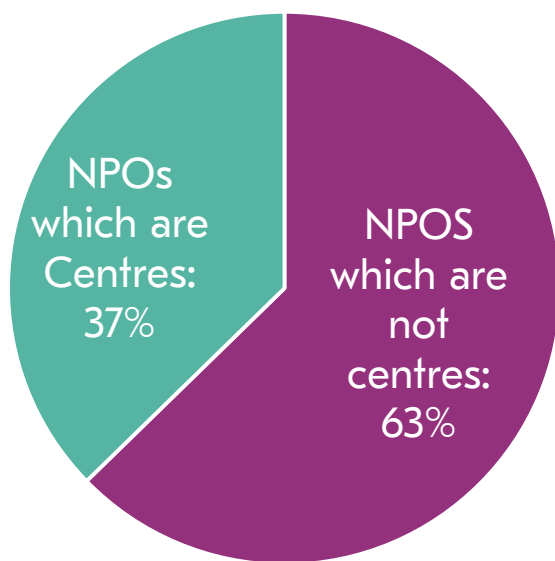

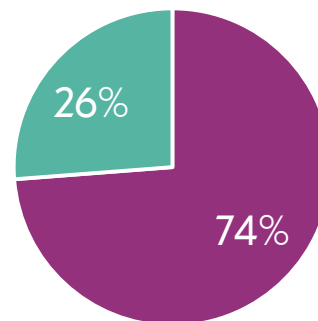

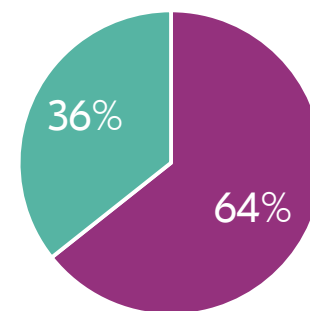

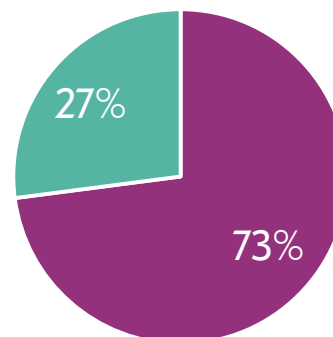

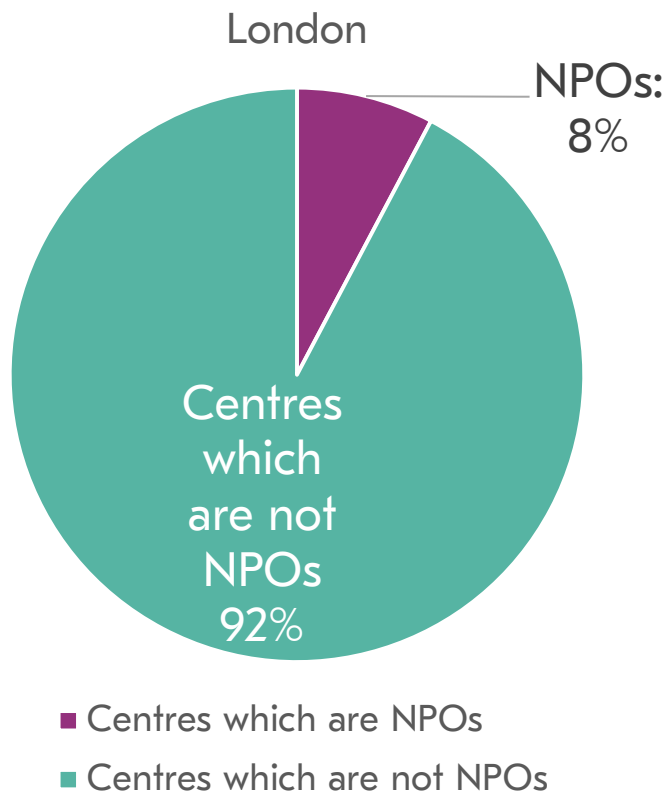

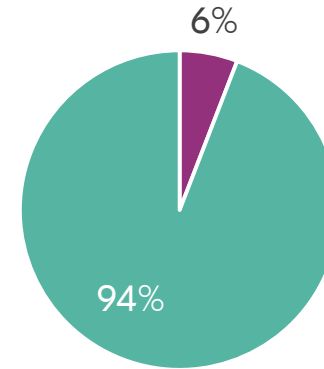

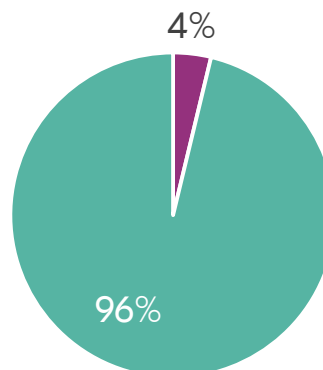

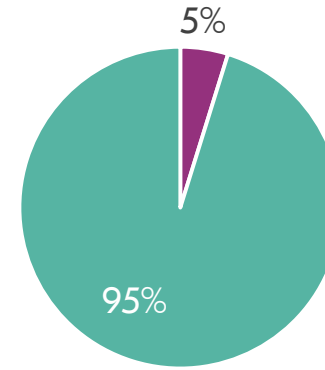

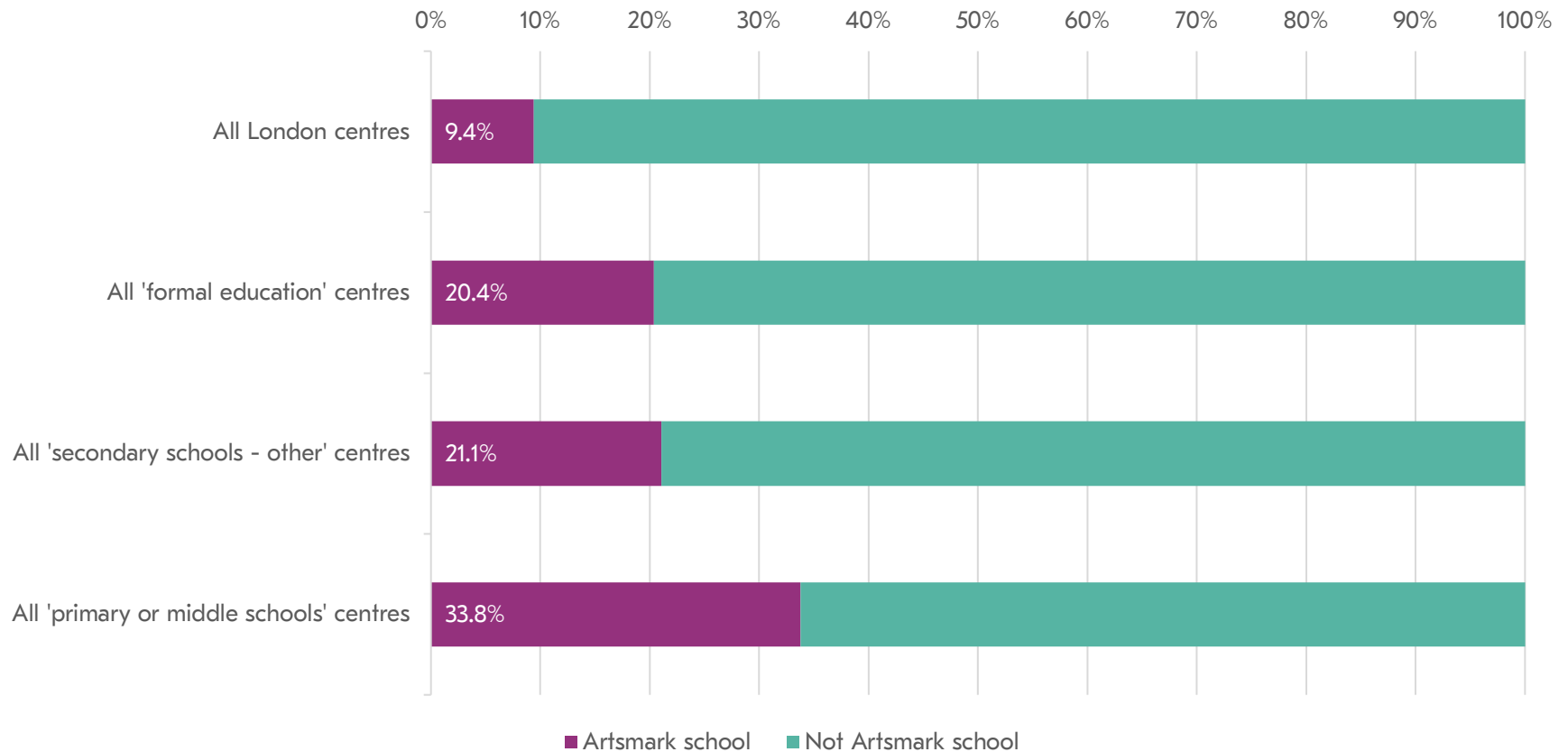

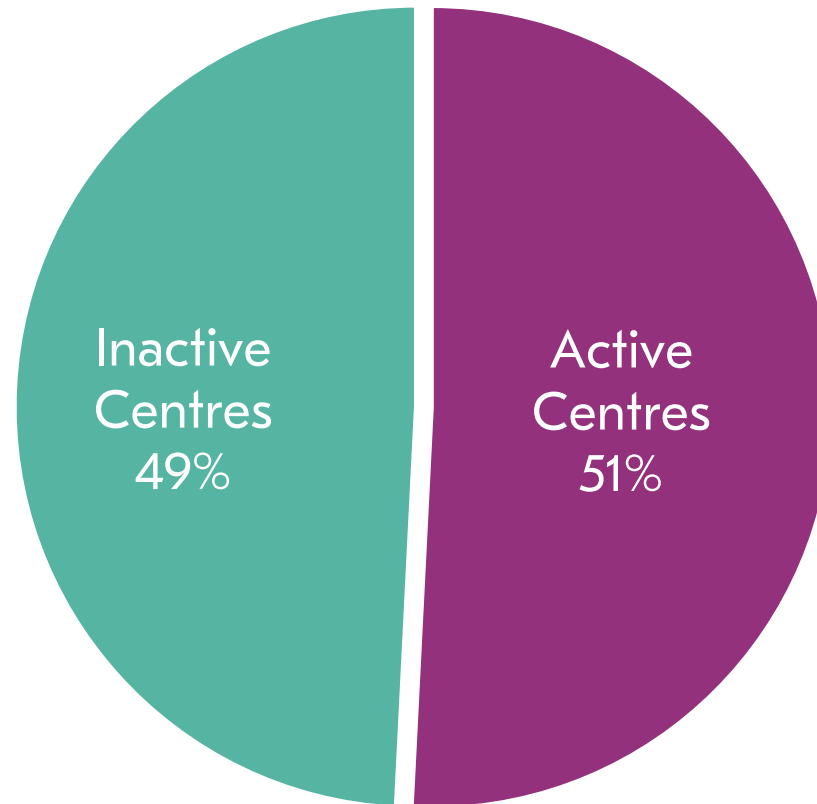

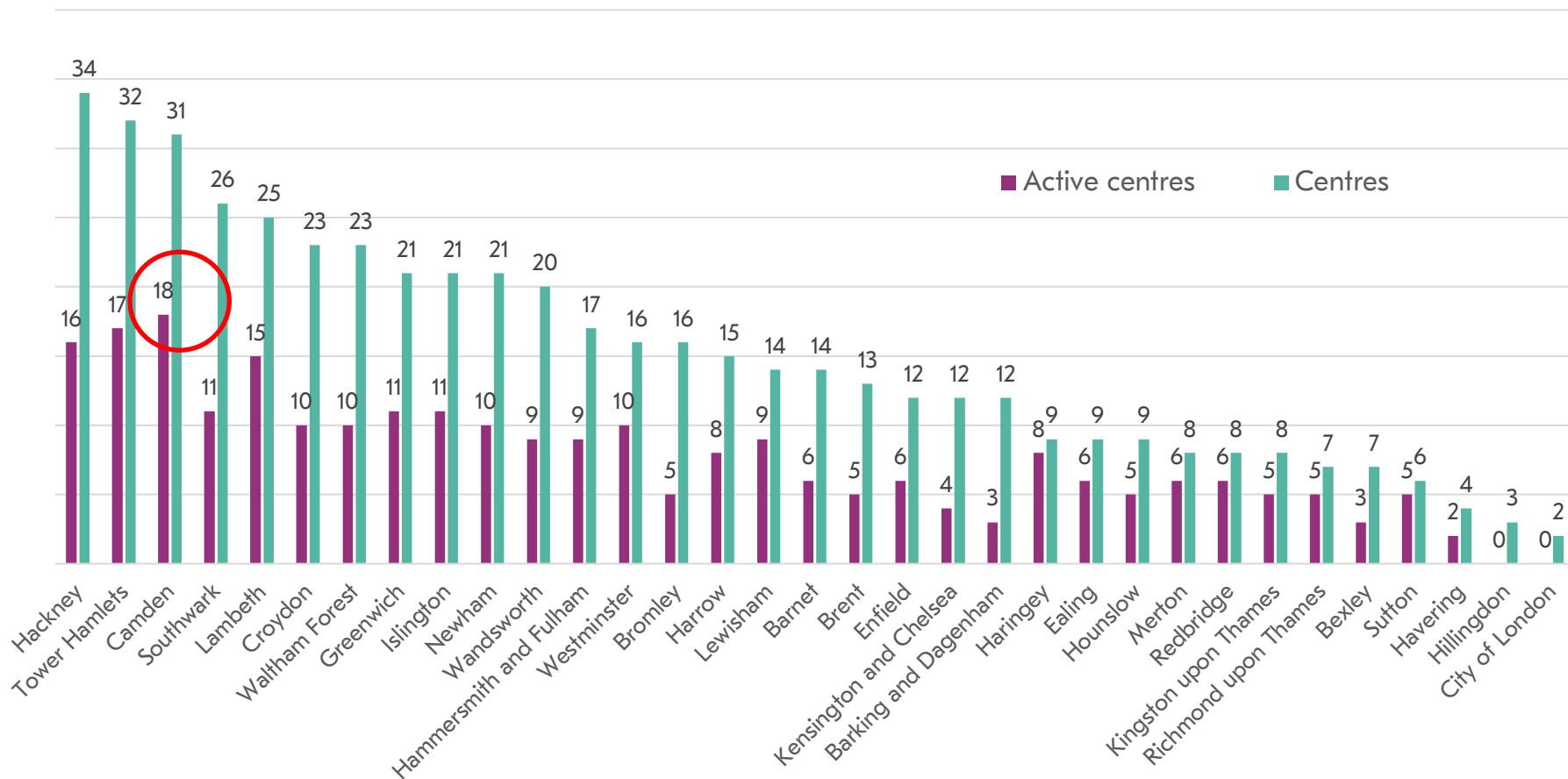


Percentage and number of Arts Award centres in London offering moderations between Apr-17 – Mar-18, of 500 total centres.

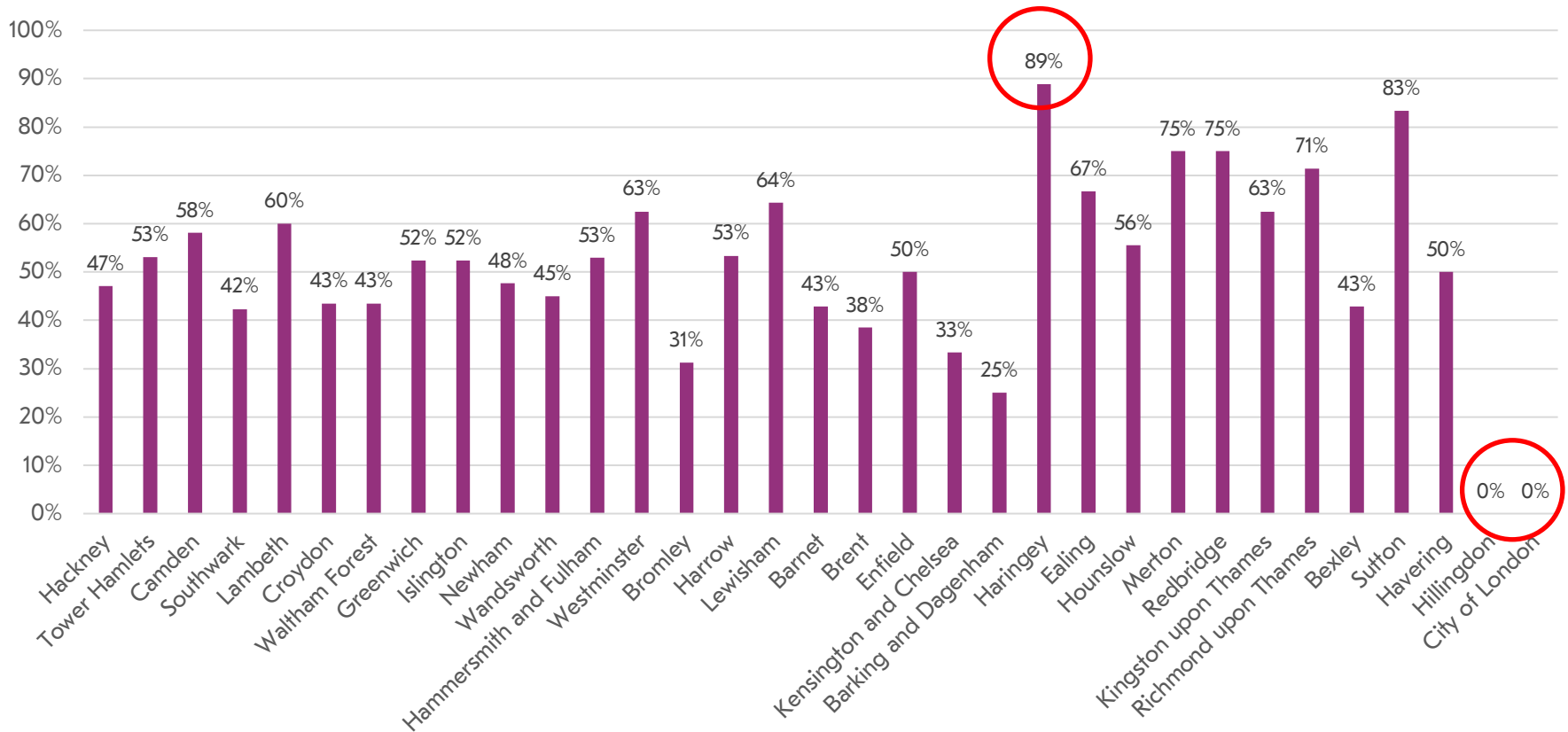
Registered centres and centres actively delivering in London between Apr-17-Mar-18 by borough.

Percentage of centres that are active

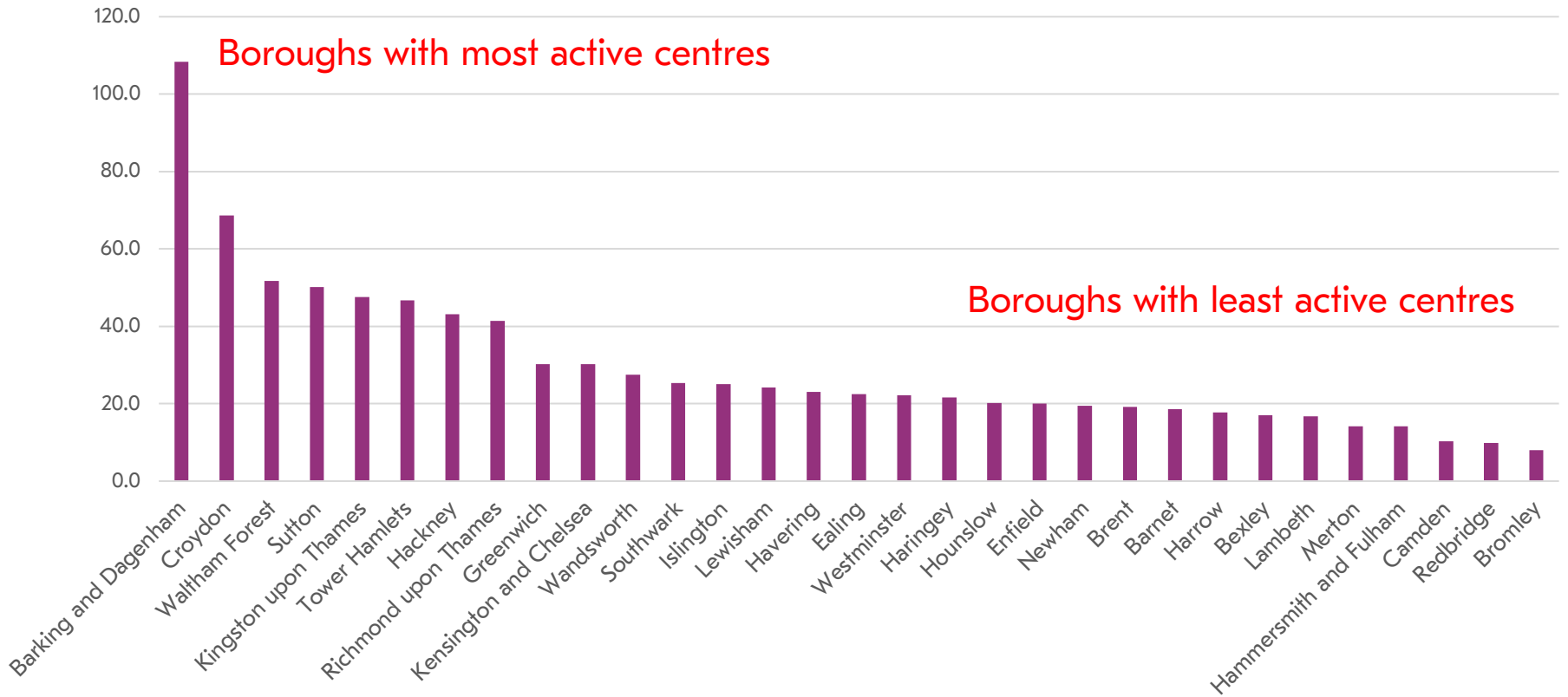

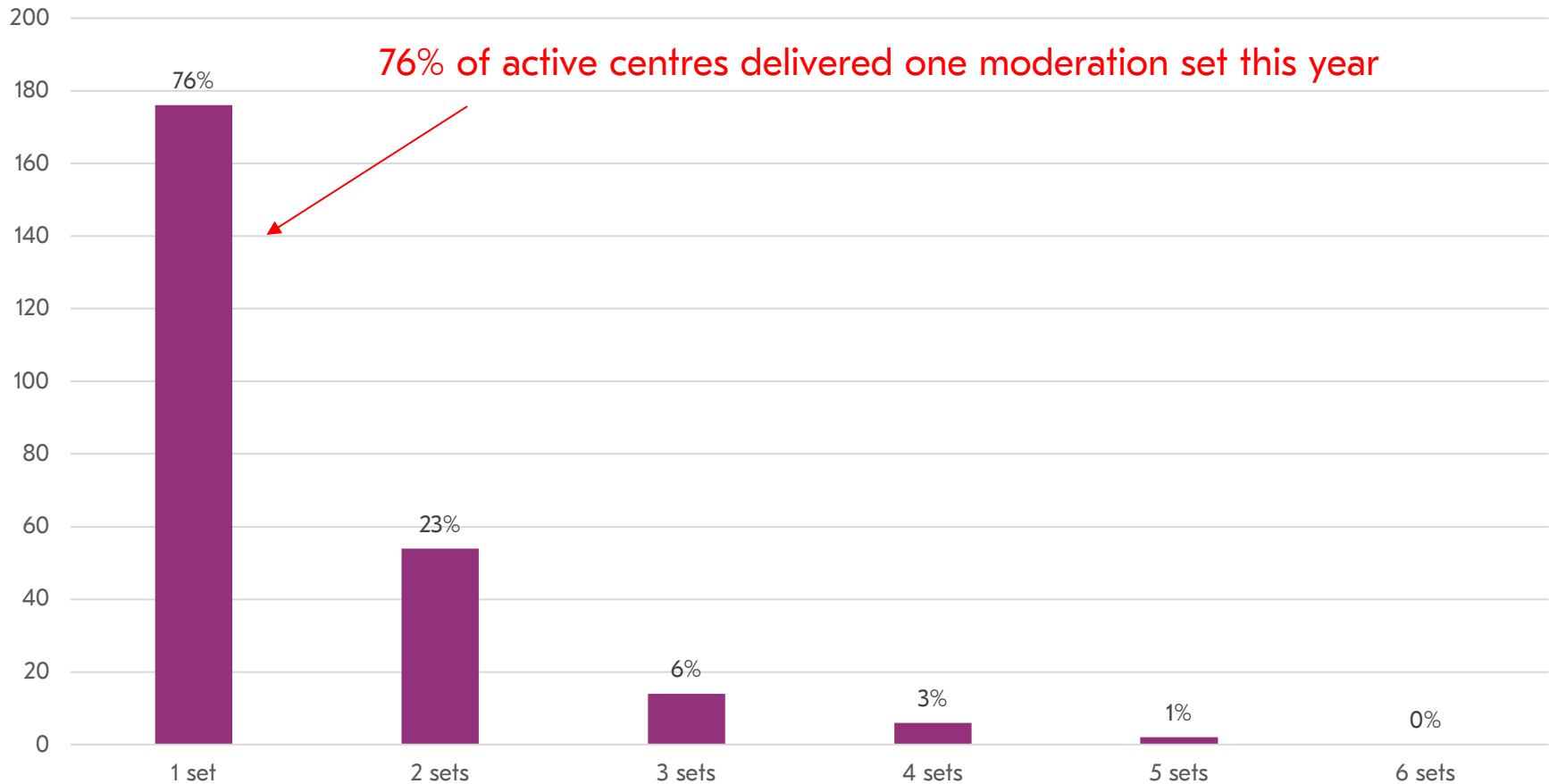

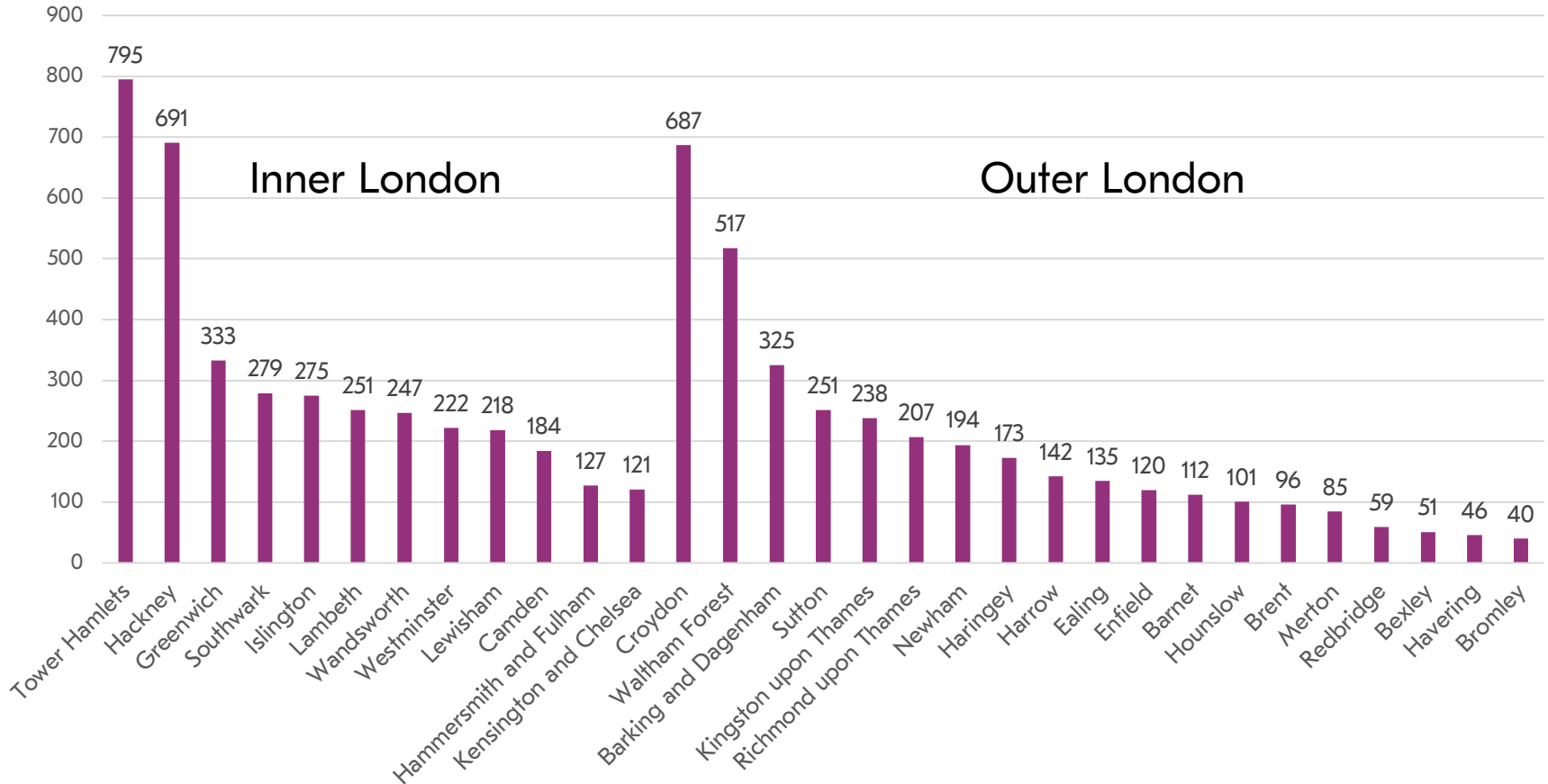

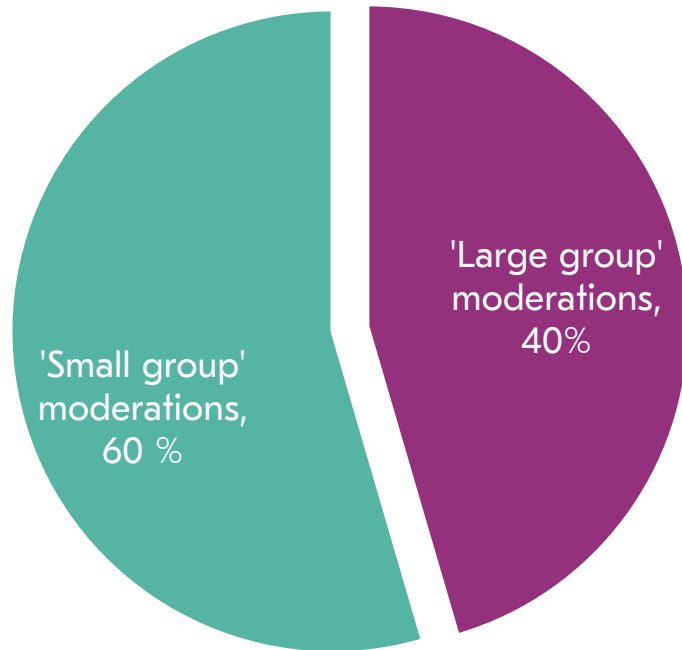

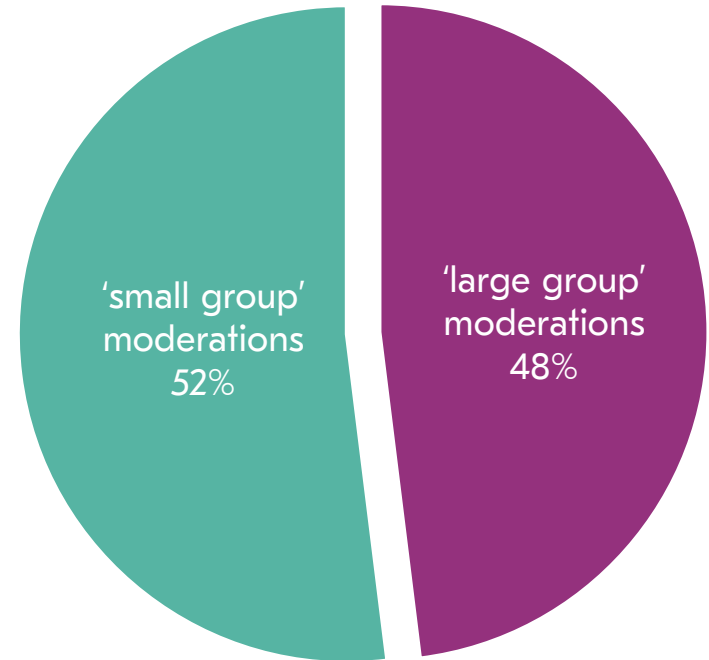

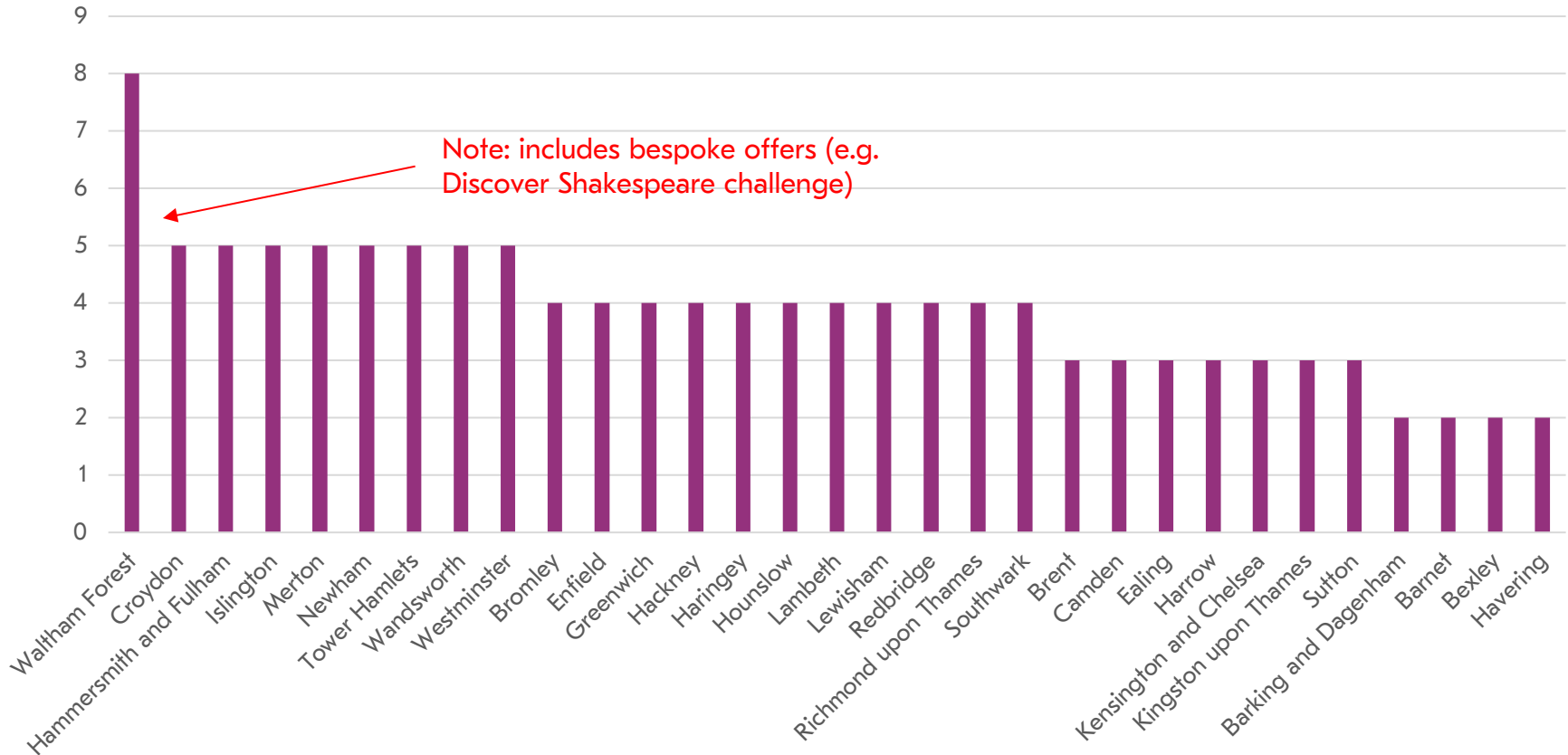

Number of levels offered, by borough

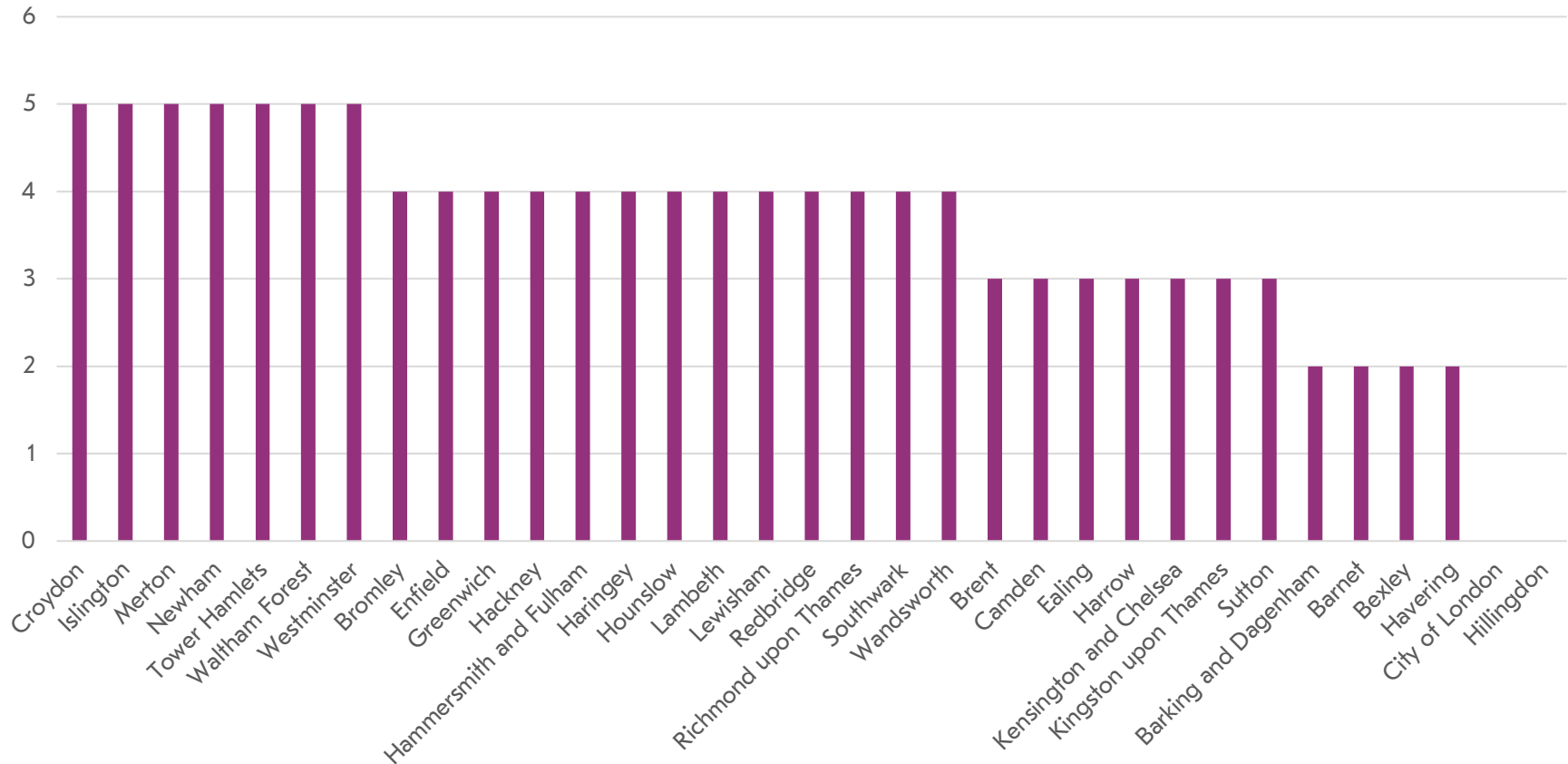

Number of levels offered, simplified, by borough

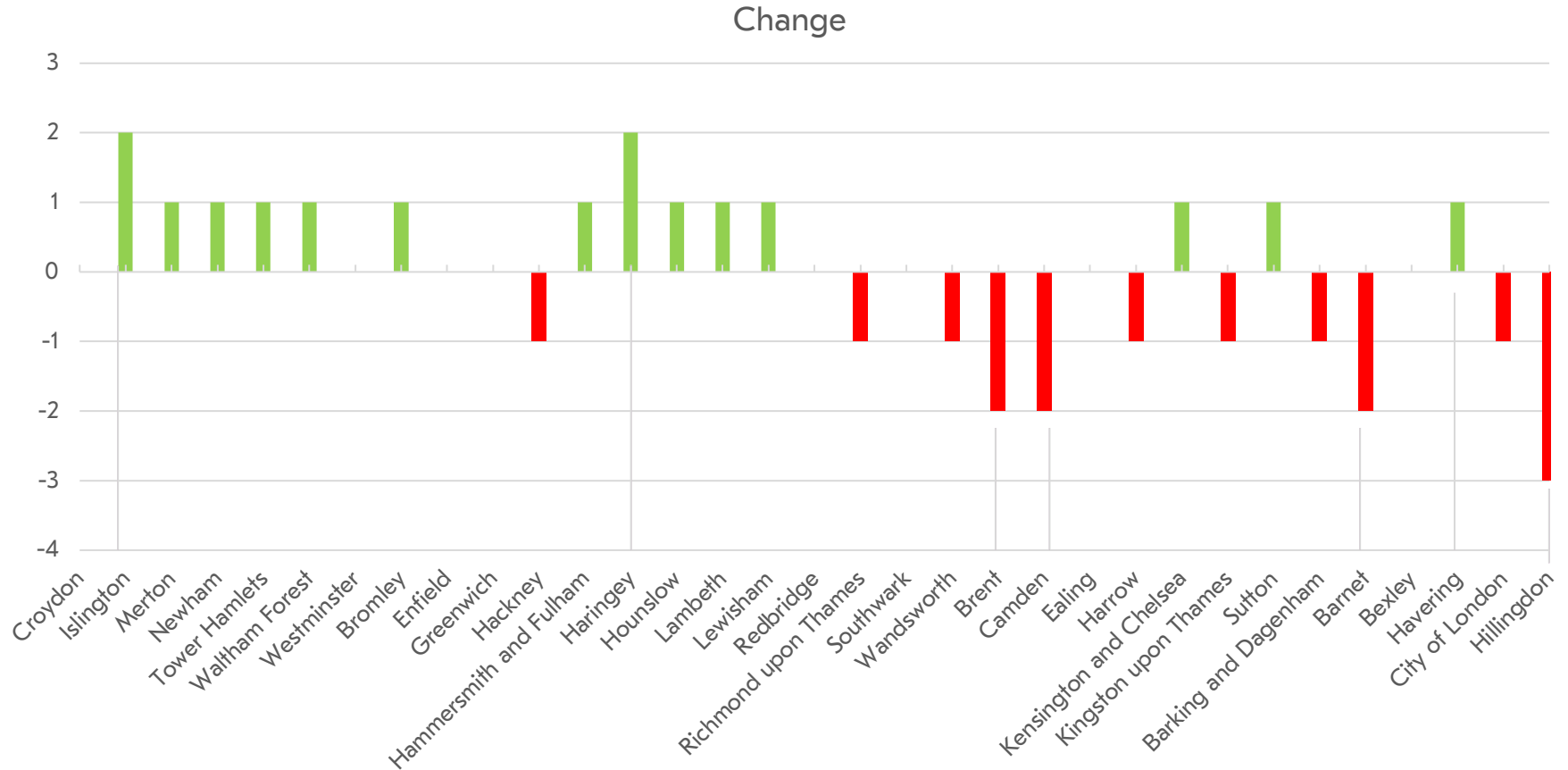

Glossary

Arts Award – A programme that allows young people aged 5 to 25 to get involved in arts and cultural activities, be inspired and grow as artists and arts leaders. It offers them a chance to develop their creativity, communication and leadership skills and get recognised through a group of national qualifications

Centre - An organisation that is registered to support young people in achieving their Arts Award

Supporter - An organisation or artist offering activities that young people can use towards their Arts Award, such as workshops, arts and cultural events which they can review, opportunities to find out about artists and cultural opportunities, a chance to share skills or lead arts projects

Level - Arts Award has five levels, four of which (Explore, Bronze, Silver and Gold) are accredited qualifications. Arts Award Discover is an introductory award.

Adviser – A trained professional supporting a young person as they are undertaking Arts Award and assessing their achievement

Moderation – Once the young person has completed all tasks related to their Arts Award a trained Arts Award Moderator checks the Adviser's assessment for the accredited levels
