

Creative Facilitator

A New Direction are looking for a freelance Creative Facilitator to work with us on We Belong, our brand new programme designed to tackle loneliness by building a supportive community and creative platform to empower children in care.

We Belong is an arts enrichment programme and aims to:

- Build relationships between looked after children and local authorities
- Connect children in care with each other
- Raise awareness of their experiences and give them a space, platform and a voice

We aim to achieve these aims through a series of sessions that provide a breathing space and guide the young people to try new things, learn new skills, uncover hidden talents and creativity, all while empowering them to make change.

Key responsibilities

The lead Facilitator will:

- Work with the core A New Direction team to design and deliver the pilot year of We Belong
- Lead 10 days of creative activity and cultural visits supported by a team of freelance Creative Practitioners and one project/pastoral support worker
- Coordinate a team of creative practitioners who will design and deliver appropriate arts enrichment activity for the group
- Plan and accompany the young people on creative and cultural visits
- Support the young people to develop the We Belong campaign, with the aim of raising public awareness of the care experience
- Connect with other organisations that can advise and/or advocate for the rights of children in care and care leavers
- Be responsible for the safety and wellbeing of participants throughout the programme
- Guide a small group of care leavers to support the programme and participants
- Liaise with the programme evaluator to ensure that all required monitoring and evaluation data is collected

The We Belong programme was co-designed by a collective of care leavers in partnership with A New Direction in 2019. Over the course of four creative sessions (March-April 2019) our Care Leavers Collective used creative mapping and research, conversations, creative writing, visioning, arts, and project design activities to produce a series of four project designs. These designs centred on the themes of Healing (or Breathing Space), Creative Expression, Connections and Awareness, which emerged as core to the process and came to serve as the ethos and foundation of We Belong.
